

ADRENALINA PARK RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Adrenalina Park, located in Sokolniki, hereinafter referred to as "**Park**" is an amusement park offering its visitors active recreation, as well as numerous attractions on the borderline of extreme sports.
2. Adrenalina Park S.C. with its registered office in Sokolniki 46/1, Kąty Wrocławskie 55-080 is the Administrator of Adrenalina Park, along with its attractions.
3. The attractions offered by the Park are designed for both adults and minors, hereinafter referred to as "**Participants**", who show relevant physical and mental conditions and have no contraindications to such type of activities.
4. All attractions in the Park are characterized by increased risk of injury.
5. The Park is also available for those not using the attractions, hereinafter referred to as "**Guests**".
6. Detailed rules and conditions for the use of particular attractions of the Park are included in the "Additional Regulations", which form an integral part of these Regulations.
7. Entering the Park and buying the ticket are tantamount to familiarizing with the contents of the Rules and Regulations and the contents of Additional Regulations and their acceptance.
8. Terms of use contained in the Rules and Regulations also apply outside the Park, if the use of an attraction involves leaving the area of the Park.
9. Contents of the Rules and Regulations are posted on the information board located in front of the entrance to the Park, as well as on its website. The contents of Additional Regulations can be found on the Park premises on information boards in front of respective attractions.
10. At the request of the Participants or Guests, the contents of the Rules and Regulations are made available in ticket boxes, and by members of staff at the Park attractions.
11. Entrance to the Park is possible only within its opening hours. The current opening hours and prices are provided at the entrance to the Park and on the Park website.
12. In case of mass events or events for groups, it is possible to determine opening hours and dates other than generally applicable.
13. Ticket price for individual attractions of the Park does not include accident insurance, which is recommended to buy by one's own for the duration of stay in the Park.
14. Minors may enter the park only under the care of adults who bear full responsibility for the children entrusted to their care and responsibility for any damage caused by them.
15. Entering pets is acceptable provided they are tethered at all times and all the other necessary measures are used to ensure the safety of Guests and Participants of the Park, as well as other animals. The owners are also obliged to clean up after their pets.
16. All persons within the Park are required to comply with all the announcements and instructions issued by the staff of the Park.
17. In the Park it is strictly forbidden to:
 - bring one's own alcoholic beverages,
 - smoke or drink alcohol while using the attractions,
 - take part in attractions under the influence of alcohol or other intoxicants,
 - bring sharp objects and other dangerous objects,
 - allow admission of persons whose status indicates the consumption of alcohol or other intoxicating substances,
 - swim in the areas of water and fish,
 - use shared equipment improperly or contrary to its intended purpose.
 - use drones and other controlled models without prior approval and instruction from park managers
18. The Park staff have at all times the right to expel a Park Participant or Guest, without the right to a refund of their ticket, in the case of:
 - breaking any of the Rules and Regulations or Additional Regulations,
 - non-compliance with the instructions of the Park staff,
 - improper behavior of one of the Participants/Guests (e.g. use of vulgar language) or behavior endangering the safety of others,
 - a reasonable suspicion that a Participant/Guest is under the influence of alcohol or other intoxicating substances.
19. When in doubt, the Park staff have the right to verify the age of a Participant or Guest.
20. When in doubt, the park staff may submit a Participant or Guest to a breathalyzer test. The Participant/Guest is obliged to comply with the request. In case of refusal, the staff have the right to expel the Participant/Guest from the Park. In case of the alcohol content in exhaled air above 0.2‰, the Park staff may not allow the participant to use the attractions of the Park.
21. All equipment available to Participants the Park has the required approvals and are made in accordance with any requirements and principles for such facilities, as well as ensure the safety provided by the Participants to comply with the established rules and instructions and

- recommendations of the staff.
22. The park equipment made available to the Participants passes all inspections required by the manufacturer and is regularly checked and maintained.
 23. The Park staff have adequate training to perform in their position.

 24. Before using any of attractions, each Participant is provided with the appropriate equipment and undergoes mandatory training in the terms of use of an attraction, as well as general safety rules in the Park.
 25. **Necessary condition of participation in Adrenalina Park activities is signing a statement about accepting all rules and regulations. The statement has to be signed by adult guest or if underage by their legal guardian. The statement is attached to tickets, online offer or provided by Adrenalina Park staff.**
 26. Failure to follow safety rules, the recommendations of the Park staff, as well as improper use of the equipment may expose a Participant, other Participants or Guests to risk of injury or even death, for which the park Administrator does not bear responsibility.
 27. In the event of bad weather or other unforeseen events that may threaten the safety and lives of Participants/Guests, the Park Administrator may decide to ban the use of some or all of the attractions, as well as closing the Park.
 28. Persons suffering from heart disease or other conditions, which in the case of physical exertion can endanger their life or health, should not use the Park attractions. The use of the attractions by the persons is at their sole risk.
 29. When using attractions, the Participant / Guest should be dressed in a comfortable, sporty outfit. In the event of damage to clothing or other items of the outfit, the Administrator is not responsible for any damage that was not a result of faulty equipment and facilities of the Park.

 30. All accidents, injuries, wounds, etc. must be reported immediately to the Park staff, which will provide the injured with first aid and, if necessary, contact medical care representatives.
 31. After each of the reported events, a Park employee will draw up an accident report in the presence of the victim, in which a date and place of the accident are noted, as well as the extent of injuries suffered by the victim, and provided method of assistance.
 32. The accident report will be drawn up in two identical copies signed by an employee of the Park and the victim, one for the victim and one for the Park Administrator.
 33. For events occurring in the Park, which will not be notified immediately after their occurrence, the Park Administrator does not bear responsibility.

 34. The Park Administrator has liability insurance to third parties for damages arising out of the activities carried out.
 35. Any claim related to damage caused in the Park should be reported to the Park Administrator or directly to the current Insurer of the Park Administrator, after obtaining contact details of the Insurer from the Park Administrator and the number of the policy referred to in point 1.
 36. To the report of damage the victim is obliged to attach an accident report drawn up by an employee of the Park in accordance with § 7 of the Rules and Regulations.

 37. The Park Administrator is not liable for accidents that occurred in the Park and outside it due to non-compliance of the provisions of these Rules and Regulations and Additional Regulations, as well as the recommendations of the Park staff.
 38. The Park Administrator is also not responsible for damage caused to the Participant/Guest by the actions of another Participant/Guest.
 39. In the event of damage or destruction by the Participant/Guest any piece of the Park equipment, as well as destruction, damage or loss of entrusted items, Participant/Guest is obliged to repair the damage caused in full.
 40. In the case referred to above, or using the Park attractions in a manner inconsistent with its intended purpose, contrary to the Park Rules and Regulations, Additional Regulations or instructions of the Park staff, the Participant/Guest is additionally obliged to compensate the Park for the damage resulting from the inability to use the equipment or Park attraction by other Participants.
 41. The Park Administrator informs about the possibility of incurring criminal liability by the Participant/Guest on account of destruction or damage to property, in accordance with Art. 288 § 1 of the Criminal Code and Art. 124 § 1 of the Petty Offence Code.
 42. The Park Administrator is not responsible for items lost, stolen, or left without proper supervision in the Park, particularly for valuables and money.
 43. Items found in the Park will be stored for a period of one month by the Park Administrator and can be received by their owners within this time.
 44. Each Participant/Guest is obliged to notify the Park staff of any reservations, concerns or comments concerning both the technical condition of the Park equipment and all the objects and

devices made available to him/her, as well as to their own well-being and other distressing symptoms.

45. In the park there may be taken some photos for advertising purposes. If guests does not agree to post photos of them they have to let the stuff of the park know.
46. The Park Administrator is not responsible for the Participant/Guest not familiarizing himself/herself with the content of these Rules and Regulations and Additional Regulations.
47. The Park Administrator is not obliged to inform the Participants/Guests about changes in contents of the Rules or Regulations and Additional Regulations. In the case of change of the Regulations or its part, the new content will replace the existing one and will be made available to interested parties as defined in § 2. 3, 4 of these Regulations.
48. Any disputes arising out from the usage of the Park and its attractions shall be resolved amicably by the parties and in the case of legal action the competent court shall be the court having jurisdiction over the Park Administrator's seat.

ADDITIONAL REGULATIONS: RESTRICTIONS IN ADRENALINA PARK:

RESTRICTIONS on attractions in brief:

Rope parks route I – height: min.135 cm, weight: max. 120kg, the person must fulfill the psychomotor conditions

Rope park route II – height: min. 150cm, weight: max. 120 kg, the person must fulfill the psychomotor conditions

Rope park for children – min. 3 years old, height from 120 cm to 135 cm (entry up to 150 cm possible - not recommended due to the low level of difficulty), the person must fulfill the psychomotor conditions

Zip- lining 320m – height: from 140cm; weight: max. 100kg, the person must fulfill the psychomotor conditions

Zip- lining 155m – height: from 135cm, weight: max. 100kg, the person must fulfill the psychomotor conditions

Zip – lining for children 100m – height: max. 140cm, max. 60kg; the person must fulfill the psychomotor conditions

Eurobungee trampoline – weight: max. 45 kg, the person must fulfill the psychomotor conditions

Zorbing – weight: max. 90 kg, height: min. 150 cm, the person must fulfill the psychomotor conditions

Zorbing for children - the person must fulfill the psychomotor conditions

ATVs – age: min. 16 years old, the person must fulfill the psychomotor conditions

ATVs for children – min. 6 years, max. 90kg, the person must fulfill the psychomotor conditions

Segways – min. 12 years old, weight: min. 45 kg, max. 110 kg, the person must fulfill the psychomotor conditions

Shooting ranges - the person must fulfill the psychomotor conditions

Paintball – min. 18 years old independently, min. 15 years old with the consent of the legal guardian, the person must fulfill the psychomotor conditions

All attractions in the Park are characterized by increased risk of injury.

Every person that wants to go on activities must carefully listen to the instructor commands and use the equipment and vehicles in accordance with the instructions.

Necessary condition of participation in Adrenalina Park activities is signing a statement about accepting all rules and regulations.

ADDITIONAL REGULATIONS FOR ROPE PARKS AND ZIP LINES

1. There are 3 rope parks within the Adrenalin Park (rope park I, rope park II, rope park for children) and 4 Ziplines (100 meters, 155 meters, 2x320 meters high).
2. The rope park and zipline are attractions with an increased risk of injury. A person deciding to participate in attractions accepts this fact. The use of attractions takes place at the own risk of the user, and in the case of minors, under the sole responsibility of the parent or guardian.
3. Entry to attractions is possible after signing the declaration on the acceptance of the park's rules by an adult participant or legal guardian.
4. Admission to the Rope Park and Zipline routes is payable according to the currently valid price list.
5. Limitations on individual routes:
 - o Rope Park I: persons with the height of min. 135 cm, weighing max. 120kg.
 - o Rope Park II: people with the height of min. 150cm, weighing max. 120kg.
 - o Ropes park for children: persons from 3 years of age, height from 120 cm to 135 cm (entry up to 150 cm possible - not recommended due to the low level of difficulty)
 - o Zipline 100m: height: max. 140cm, weight: max. 60kg,
 - o Zipline 155m: people with the height of min. 135cm, weight: max. 100kg,
 - o Zipline 320m: people with the height of min. 140cm, weighing max. 100kg.
6. The routes of all rope parks and ziplines are equipped with a continuous protection system, consisting in pulling the catch through steel handles installed on trees, without the need to intersect.
7. When using Rope Parks and Ziplines, each Participant is obliged to adhere to the general principles and safety rules contained in the Adrenaline Park Regulations as well as instructions and specific recommendations provided by Park employees.
8. Persons wishing to use the Rope Parks and Ziplines must receive from the Park employee the fall protection equipment and appropriate training.
9. The rules of correct use of attractions included in the training:

Rope parks and Ziplines (continuous belaying):

 - When entering the route, attach the safety hook to the rope marked in red. When you leave the route, unhook the hook.
 - Only one person can stay in one obstacle. Two people can stay on one platform.
 - When descending on ropes marked with yellow, attach the block in front of the safety hook, then place the hook on the block. During the ride on the block you should only hold onto the lunge of the block and not grab the steel rope, because of the risk of serious injury.
 - In the last phase of the zip-line, do not reach out towards the mattress.
 - If you are unable to stop on the platform and get pulled back, wait until you stopped and then, grab the rope, pull up to the platform, setting our head in the direction of ride
 - When changing the direction of the route (shortcuts) use the crossover
10. Entry to any elements of Rope Parks and Tyrolek is possible only with the consent of the Park employee.
11. It is forbidden to self-regulate or make any changes to the safety equipment established or corrected by the Park employee.
12. Persons wearing jewelry, glasses or other accessories should properly protect them so that they do not pose a threat to their health or life.
13. People who wear long hair should hide them under the helmet so that they do not screw in the blocks and other elements of the park.
14. When using rope parks and tyroles, you should behave calmly, do not jump over obstacles and do not run and absolutely instruct your instructor.

ADDITIONAL REGULATIONS FOR QUADS AND SEGWAYS

1. Quad (ATV) is four-wheel vehicle with engine, intended for use by a single operator. Segway is a two-wheel vehicle, electric, intended for use by a single operator.
2. Quad and segway are characterized by increased risk of injury. Every participant decided to use those attractions accept that fact.
3. Using quad/segway is possible only after payment of the fee, according to current price list.
4. Necessary condition of participation in Adrenalina Park activities is signing a statement about accepting all rules and regulations.
5. During using quad/segway every participant is obligated to obey terms of use and safety rules included in Adrenalina Park Rules and Regulations and to instructions and recommendations from Park staff and to sign statment in presence of Park staff.
6. There are two types of quads available in the Park:
 - big, for participants above 16 years old
 - small, for children above 6 years old with psychophysical conditions as specified by the manufacturer
7. All participants have to wear helmet.
8. Attractions are used under sole responsibility of participant or, in case of minors, under sole responsibility of parent or guardian of child.
9. The ride takes place only on the designated route.
10. Participants are obligated to maintain safe speed and distance between vehicles. Participant causing danger situations may be removed from the route.

ADDITIONAL REGULATIONS FOR PAINTBALL

1. Paintball is a kind of team game, which involves running a fake fight with the use of markers, devices similar in shape and principle of operation to pneumatic weapons, which using compressed gas eject balls filled with food gelatin based paint.
2. Paintball is an attraction with an increased risk of injury. A person deciding to participate in attractions accepts this fact. The use of attractions takes place at the own risk of the user, and in the case of minors, under the sole responsibility of the parent or guardian.
3. Necessary condition of participation in Adrenalina Park activities is signing a statement about accepting all rules and regulations.
4. **Paintball can be used by people over 18 years of age, after paying the fee in accordance with the current price list. Minors may use the Paintball game from the age of 15 only with the consent of their parents or legal guardians.**
5. During the play in Paintball, each Participant is obliged to adhere to the general rules and safety rules contained in the Adrenaline Park Regulations as well as instructions and detailed recommendations provided by the Park's employees.
6. Shooting with a pneumatic weapon (a painball karabiner) can only take place on the designated area, hereinafter referred to as the playing field.
7. It is forbidden to top up the magazine with balls that were lying on the ground.
8. In the Field of play, an absolute requirement to wear a protective mask is

Protective clothing should be carefully worn throughout the duration of the game.</p> <p>10. Outside the playing field, the weapon must be secured and directed to the ground with the barrel.</p> <p>11. It is forbidden to shoot at the opponent from a distance of less than 5 meters.</p> <p>12. The player is eliminated from the game when hit by a ball with paint by another participant (hit the weapon or footwear also eliminates the game).</p> <p>13. The player eliminated without taking off the protective mask raises his free hand upright, while the other hand, in which he holds the marker, lowers towards the ground pointing the barrel of the rifle down and thus, efficiently and with the shortest path possible, leaves the playing field.</p> <p>14. Exclusion from the game is possible when:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> o The player will leave the playing field. o After the first hit, he continues to shoot at the opponent (despite the clear signal from the hit person). o Repeatedly violates the security regulations in force on the territory of the couple. <p>15. Only players participating in the game may be in the field of the game, and persons not participating in the game, their behavior should not affect its course.</p> <p>16. It is forbidden to direct fire outside the game.</p> <p>17. If it is determined that the Participant has removed the mask, immediately stop the fire and notify the Park employee of the game.</p> <p>18. It is forbidden to put the gun on a dirty ground.</p> <p>19. It is prohibited to dismantle, regulate and improve weapons.</p> <p>20. In the event of any malfunctioning of weapons or equipment, the game should be discontinued, leave the playing field with raised hand and ask the Park employee acting for further instructions.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">ADDITIONAL REGULATIONS FOR SHOOTING RANGES</p> <p>1. Shooting range can be used only after payment of a fee, in accordance with the currently valid price list.</p> <p>2. Necessary condition of participation in Adrenalina Park activities is signing a statement about accepting all rules and regulations.</p> <p>3. Shooting ranges are characterized by increased risk of injury. Every participant decided to use those attractions accept that fact.</p> <p>4. During using shooting ranges every participant is obligated to obey terms of use and safety rules included in Adrenalina Park Rules and Regulations and to instructions and recommendations from Park staff and to sign statment in presence of Park staff.</p> <p>5. The Park employee assigns shooting positions to the shooters, and the guests and accompanying persons - a place of safe stay and observation.</p> <p>6. Guests and accompanying persons have an absolute ban on entering the shooting positions and a ban on using the weapon.</p> <p>7. In the shooting range, outside the shooting position, the weapon must be secured and directed downwards with the barrel; the bow must be unarmed.</p> <p>8. The decommissioning of weapons or arch reinforcement takes place exclusively at the shooting position.</p> <p>9. All activities related to the operation of the weapon shall be carried out only with the barrel directed towards targets or objects being the target at the shooting range. All operations related to the operation of the bow are made only with an arrow pointing towards the targets</p> <p>10. Shooting and aiming on the area of the shooting range takes place only on designated shooting positions, for shields or other objects being the target on the shooting range.</p> <p>11. The end of the shooting is reported to the Park employee who is shooting.</p> <p>12. After completing the shooting, the bow with arrows or other weapon is secured and presents to the Park employee who is shooting.</p> <p>13. It is forbidden to enter the shooting position without the consent of the Park employee shooting.</p> <p>14. The user of the shooting range, except for the disabled person, is obliged keep the rules on shooting postures.</p> <p>15. After the "STOP" command, issued by an employee of the shooting park or another person, all shooters stop the shooting immediately.</p> <p>16. Animals may be introduced to the shooting range only in exceptional cases and must be kept tethered and under the strict supervision of the guardian.</p> <p>Limitations: All shooting ranges - a person must meet psychomotor conditions. Using eurobungee trampoline is possible only after payment of the fee, according to current price list.</p> <p>2. Necessary condition of participation in Adrenalina Park activities is signing a statement about accepting all rules and regulations.</p> <p>3. Every participant is obligated to obey terms of use and safety rules included in Adrenalina Park Rules and Regulations and to instructions and recommendations from Park staff.</p> <p>4. The Eurobungee trampoline is an attraction with an increased risk of injury. The guardian of the person using the attraction accepts this fact. The use of attractions is at the sole responsibility of the parent or guardian.</p> <p>5. Eurobungee trampoline is used under sole responsibility of parent or guardian of child.</p> <p>6. Maximum weight of participant of eurobungee trampoline is 45 kg.</p> <p>7. Eurobungee trampoline is not recommended for persons with circulatory system problems or persons with limited mobility.</p> <p>8. Use of eurobungee trampoline is guarded by Park staff, who dress participant in necessary equipment.</p> <p>9. Before entering eurobungee trampoline every participant is obligated to take off shoes.</p> <p>10. Small items (glasses, keys, money, etc.) should be left in a safe place before entering the euro bungee trampoline, to prevent their lost or damage.</p>

Zorbing for children is moving about in a blown up spherical ball on a flat ground. 3. Zorbing is characterized by increased risk of injury. Every participant decided to use those attractions accept that fact. 4. Using zorbing is possible only after payment of the fee, according to current price list. 5. Necessary condition of participation in Adrenalina Park activities is signing a statement about accepting all rules and regulations. 6. During using zorbing every participant is obligated to obey terms of use and safety rules included in Adrenalina Park Rules and Regulations and to instructions and recommendations from Park staff and to sign statement in presence of Park staff. 7. Zorbing participant has to be min. 150cm high and weigh not more than 90 kg. 8. It is not recommended to use zorbing for people who have problems with the circulatory system, having limited mobility or claustrophobia. 9. The use of zorba is possible only in the presence of a Park employee who provides the Participant with the necessary security. 10. Before entering the ball, the participant is obliged to take off his shoes. 11. All light items (glasses, keys, mobile phone, money, etc.) should be deposited before entering the ball in a safe place, because they can be destroyed or lost, and also threaten the safety of people in the ball. 12. It is forbidden to enter the course of the spherical ball exit. 13. While using zorbing for children at the same time, a maximum of three children may stay in the ball. The number of participants staying in the ball at the same time is decided by the instructor. <p>Limitations: Zorba (rode down the hill) - weight up to 90 kg, Height from 150 cm, Person must meet psychomotor conditions. Zorbing for children - a person must meet psychomotor conditions.</p>	<p>Boxes Climbing – the attraction consists of climbing, placing plastic boxes underneath. The participant is dressed in a harness and helmet. The instructor protects the participant with a rope harness. The participant must meet psychomotor conditions. The attraction is characterized by an increased risk of injury. The participant is obliged to follow the instructions of the instructor.</p> <p>Jacob's ladder -the attraction lies in climbing the rope ladder. The participant is dressed in a harness and helmet. The instructor protects the participant with a rope harness. The participant must meet psychomotor conditions. The attraction is characterized by an increased risk of injury. The participant is obliged to follow the instructions of the instructor.</p> <p>Rope crossing - the attraction consists of crossing over a certain obstacle moving along the rope bridge. The participant is dressed in a harness and helmet. The participant must meet psychomotor conditions. The attraction is characterized by an increased risk of injury. The participant is obliged to follow the instructions of the instructor.</p> <p>Slackline – the attraction consists of exercises and games on a specialized tape suspended at a height of several dozen cm. The participant must meet psychomotor conditions. The participant should move on the tape carefully, do not jump, do not run, adjust to instructor's instructions. The attraction is characterized by an increased risk of injury.</p> <p>Crossing on pontoons and mini-rafting –the attraction consists in overcoming a specific section of a river or other water reservoir on a pontoon. The participant uses the attractions alone. He is obliged to properly put on a life jacket and keep it on himself until the end of the attraction. The participant must meet psychomotor conditions. The attraction is characterized by an increased risk of injury.</p>
